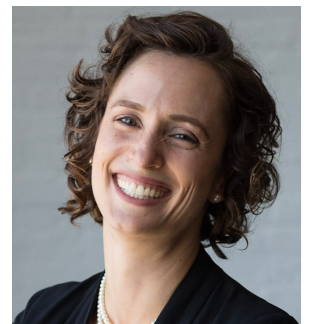


John Barrow: Reform elections, restore voting rights
