<b>April 27, 2020</b>	Advanced In Person (Early) Voting begins for the General Primary, Nonpartisan, and Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385

<b>September 15, 2020</b>	Earliest day for a registrar to mail an absentee ballot for the November General Election and Special Election O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384
<b>October 5, 2020</b>	Last day a person may register and be eligible to vote in the November General Election and Special Election Runoff for Local and State Offices. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-224
<b>October 12, 2020</b>	Advanced In Person (Early) Voting begins for the November General Election and Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385
<b>October 24, 2020</b>	Mandatory Saturday Voting for the November General Election and Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385
<b>As soon as possible</b>	Absentee ballots shall be mailed out as soon as possible prior to the General Election and Special Election Runoffs for Local and State Offices. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384  Advanced In Person (Early) Voting begin for the General Election and Special Election Runoffs for Local and State Offices. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385
<b>November 18, 2020</b>	Earliest day for a registrar to mail an absentee ballot for the General Election Runoff for Federal Offices. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384
<b>December 14, 2020</b>	Advanced In Person (Early) Voting begins for the General Election Runoff for Federal Offices. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385

*\*O.C.G.A. § 21-2-14. When the last day for the exercise of any privilege or discharge of any duty prescribed or required by this chapter shall fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the next succeeding business day shall be the last day for the exercise of such privilege or the discharge of such duty.*
